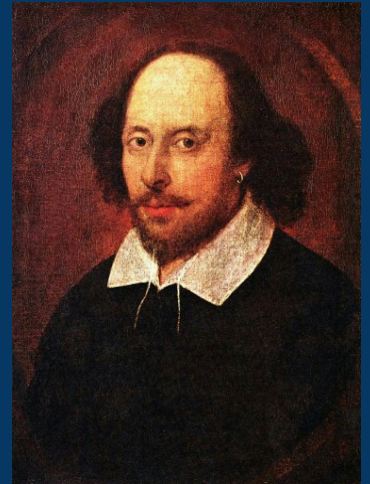

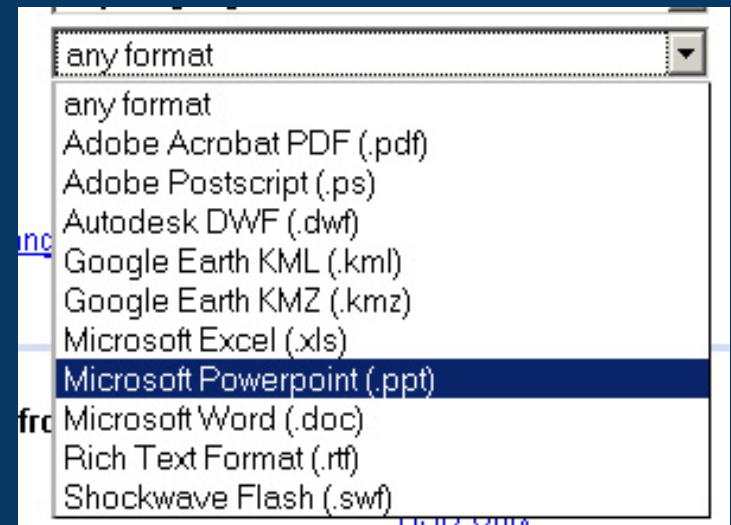

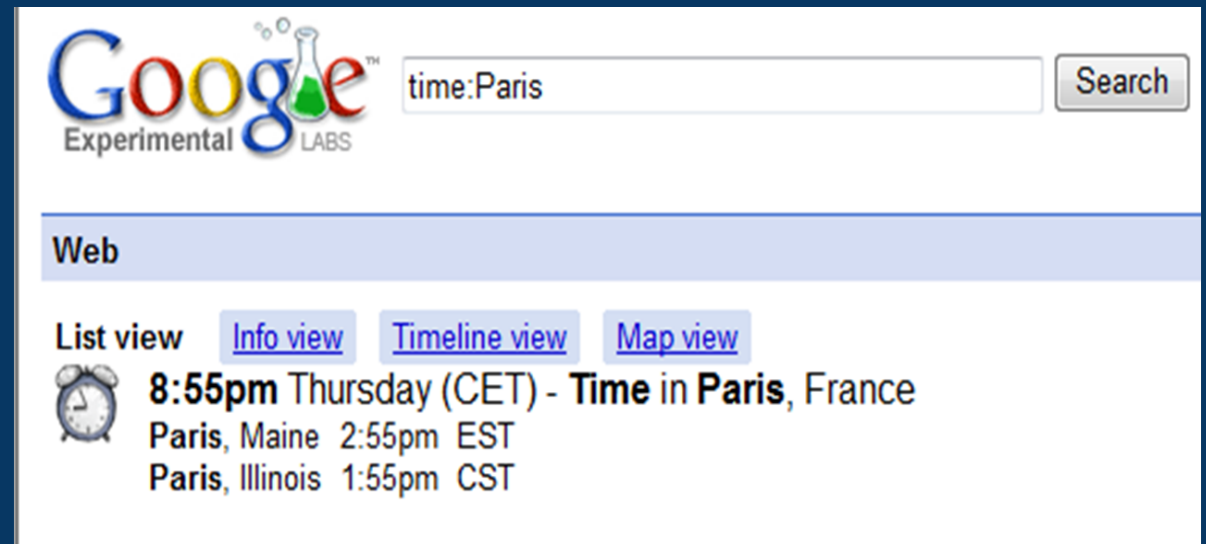

Search Tips

Use Google Squared

Google squared quickly creates a "cheat sheet" of basic information. This one (US Presidents) was created in a single click! Print it out, save it as a spreadsheet file, or use it as a website!


